


## **Top 20 Things You Should Know**

We want to make your visit as enjoyable as possible, so we've put together a list of the Top 20 things you should know about Purina Farms. - 1) The address for Purina Farms is 500 William Danforth Way, Gray Summit, MO 63039.
- 2) To travel to Purina Farms, take Hwy 44 West or East to Exit 253. Go ¼ mile North on Hwy 100. Make a left on Hwy MM and proceed to the entrance of Purina Farms, which is less than a mile on the left.
- 3) The property features include:
  - · Visitor Center educational and entertaining activities for pet lovers of all ages
  - Purina Event Center dog and cat events, including conformation shows and performance trials open to spectators.
  - Multiple outdoor event areas where dog clubs and other organizations regularly host events. Please specify to the guard at the front entrance gate, your intended destination, so you will be directed to the right place.
- 4) Outside food and beverage are not allowed on property. Concession options are available.
- 5) The Purina Event Center is handicap accessible, along with most areas in the Visitor Center. We're happy to accommodate any of our guests needs.
- 6) Admission to the Visitor Center is always free, but there may be a charge for parking during special events. Reservations for the Visitor Center are only required for large groups of 15 or more and field trips as well as when noted for special annual events. To make reservations, call 1-888-688-PETS (7387), Mon-Fri between 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.
- 7) The Visitor Center operates Mid-April through October from 9:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Wednesday-Sunday.
- 8) The Incredible Dog Arena is adjacent to our Visitor Center. It features canine performances of dog diving, agility and flying disc (weather permitting).
  - Performances are at 10:30a.m. and 1:30 p.m. each day we are open.
- 9) Cow-milking demonstrations take place at the Visitor Center each day we are open.
  - Milking times are 10a.m. & 1p.m. Space is limited, so please arrive at the milking area 15 minutes prior for a good spot.
- 10) Other Visitor Center activities include wagon rides, interactive exhibits, animal petting arena, gift shop, snack bar, hayloft play area and an indoor theater. Our outdoor plaza at the Visitor Center is perfect for enjoying a bite to eat and our gift shop features a variety of collectibles and apparel as well as pet food and toys.
- 11) Honor your pets who have crossed the rainbow bridge and keep their memory alive by placing your pet's tag, or a replica one that can be purchased at the Purina Farms gift shop, on a dedicated memorial fence on property. For a small donation, your personalized tag will hang on the fenceline for all petloving guests to read and remember forever.
- 12) The interactive Better with Pets Exhibit at the Visitor Center shows why life is better with a pet. The exhibit fosters a greater appreciation for pets, a better understanding of proper pet care and a desire to get more involved in the pet welfare cause.
- 13) You are welcome to bring your dog to Purina Farms, but you must abide by the guidelines stated in our Visiting Pet Guidelines.   - You are limited to the areas you may go at the Visitor Center. The Animal Barn and Pet Center are offlimits for the safety of our resident animals.
  - Unless you are competing, you may only bring your dog to the Purina Event Center during events designated as dog-friendly for the general public as stated on our online event calendar.

- 15) Purina Farms is a fun and SAFE place to visit. Our property features its own storm alert siren, 24 hour security and a public address system.
